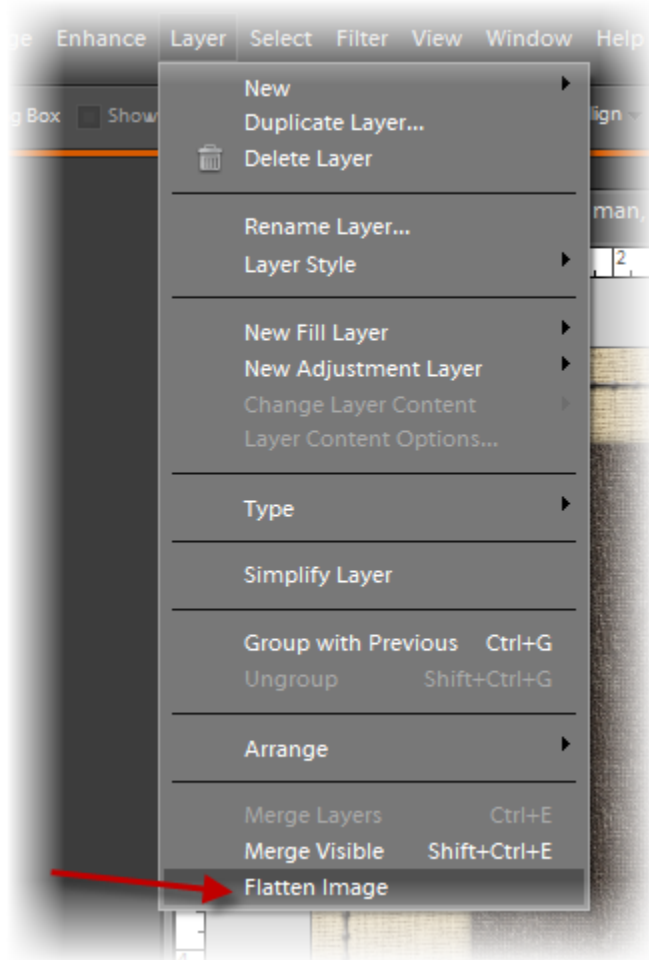


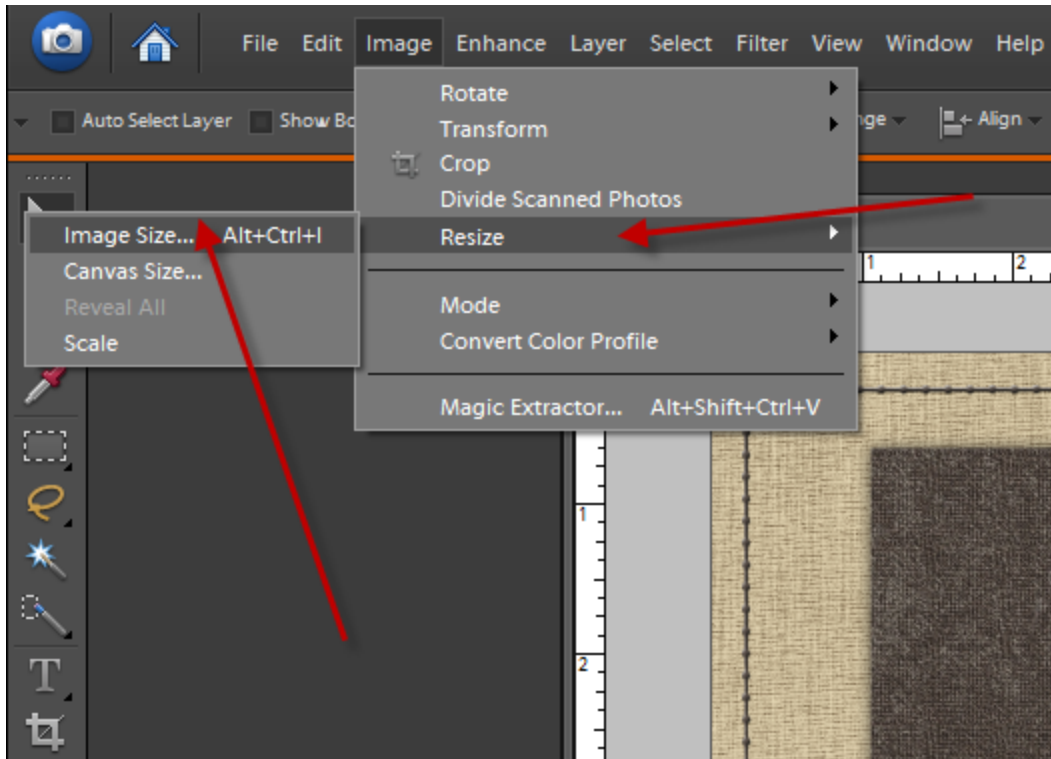


How to resize your layouts for publication for Papers and Pixels

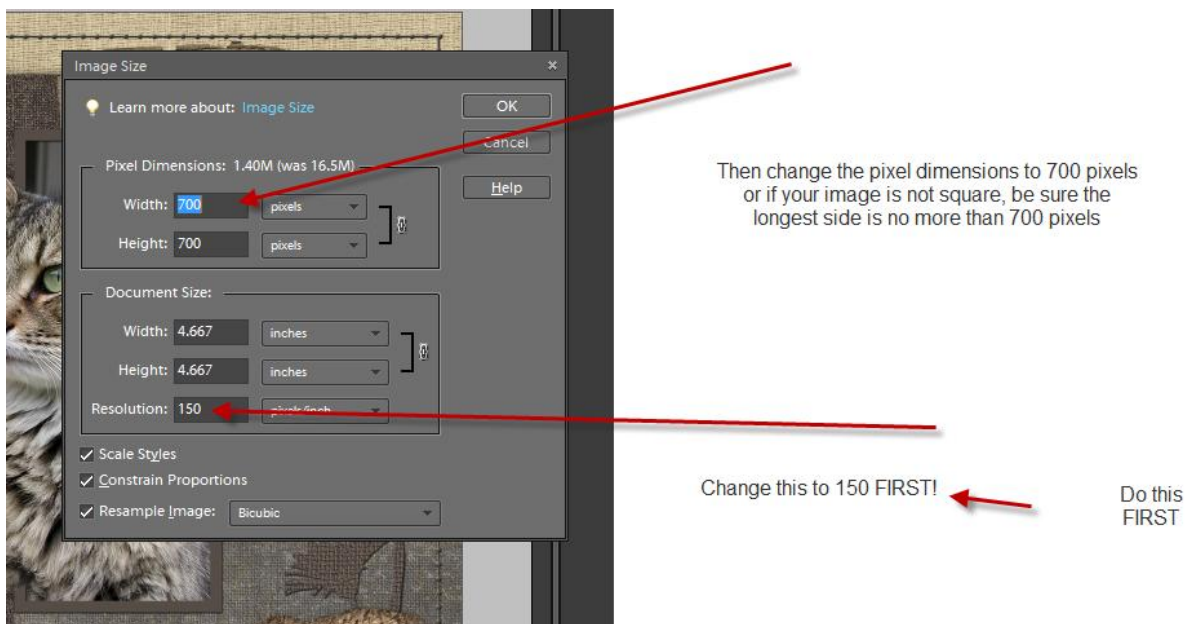
1. Flatten your .psd file (This is not absolutely necessary, but it does make the process a bit faster. Be sure to save your original .psd file before doing this.)



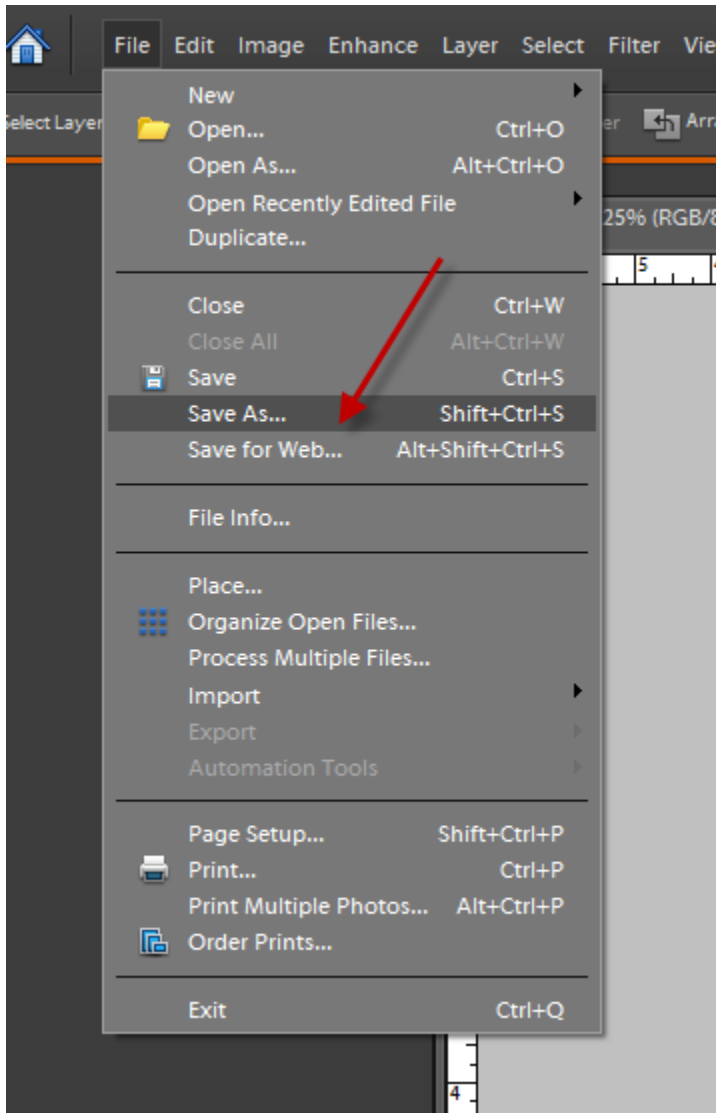
2. Choose Image>Resize>Image Size



3. In the pop up menu, change the resolution FIRST, **this is important, change it to 150.** Then you can change the numbers in the Pixel Dimensions Box to 700 pixels. The Height will automatically change when you change the width. If your image is not square, set the longest side first (be it width or height) to 700 px, the other number will change accordingly.



4. File>SaveAs. In the next pop up box, select where on your computer you want to save the file and give it a name.
